Planning and Organization for Alert Level 3 – Bubble School

As you will be aware New Zealand will remain at COVID Alert Level 4 until midnight on Tuesday 31st August when all areas south of Auckland drop to COVID Alert Level 3.

The Alert Level 3 guidance is that students should continue to work from home. Schools will open only for those students whose parents or caregivers need to work away from home and are unable to arrange alternative care for their children. Schools should continue to provide distance learning options for all students.

This means that Koraunui School will remain closed for face-to-face learning but will be open for families who have no alternative childcare arrangements for their children while they work away from home. We will provide supervision for these students while they complete online learning and work from their hard material packs under Level 3 restrictions.

Our plan is to:

1. Find out how many students are likely to come to Bubble School for supervision under COVID Level 3.

We require numbers by this date and time to set staffing levels for Bubble School.
2. Use Wednesday 1st September to clean and prepare part of the school for staff and students working in small bubbles under COVID Level 3 restrictions
3. Open Bubble School on Thursday 2nd September for students who need supervision.
4. Continue to provide online learning (and where required hard material packs) for all students. Further details will come out from the Ministry of Education on Monday so we will send an update regarding Level 3 arrangements late on Monday or on Tuesday.

Please let us know if you require any extra support or food. There are many organisations who are prepared to help, and we may be able to help with this. Most of all please look after yourself and your whanau until everything settles down again and we can return to a more normal life.
