COVID-19 Vaccination Mandate Information for Parents and Whānau

As of today Monday 15 November 2021, the COVID-19 vaccination mandate comes into effect. This means that for staff and volunteers of Koraunui School they are required to have had their first vaccination by the end of today.

Please read the information below relating to the vaccination mandate.

Who DOES need to show vaccination status

- Parents and whānau and members of the community who volunteer or help at school
- Parents and whanau and members of the community who volunteer or help on school trips both inside and out of Stokes Valley
- Parents and whanau and members of the community who volunteer or help on school sports trips and at sports events that include our students
- Parents and whanau and members of the community who coach or manage school sports teams
- Parents and whanau who attend school camps

Everyone in the above groups who are required to be vaccinated will need to provide evidence of vaccination status to either Gillian McPeake or myself. This can be the purple vaccination card, a screenshot from the [My COVID Record](#) website or a letter from their medical professional. This will be held in strict confidence.

Who DOESN'T need to show vaccination status

- Parents and whanau dropping off and picking up children will NOT need to show their vaccination status
- Parents and whanau attending meetings on school site
- Parents and whanau during school visits when enrolling their children

All parents, whānau and community members will need to continue to follow the Alert Level 2 guidelines, wear masks and follow physical distancing (2 metre) rules when on site.
