PARENTS/WHANAU ON SCHOOL GROUNDS


No parents are on site unless absolutely necessary. Everyone who must come on site must scan in.

No physical distancing required between individual students within classes.

One metre distance between students from different classes.

All classrooms will be well ventilated by keeping windows and doors open.

SCHOOL CLEANING


Enhanced school cleaning will occur. Sanitising of classrooms and high touch surfaces will take place daily.
