

PET POT PLANT

Make a pet pot plant and give it a name. It could be Blossom....or Putiputi....or Petal...
... or Bob!

FIND THE ROLY EYES IN THE PACKAGE FIRST AND PUT THEM SOMEWHERE SAFE!

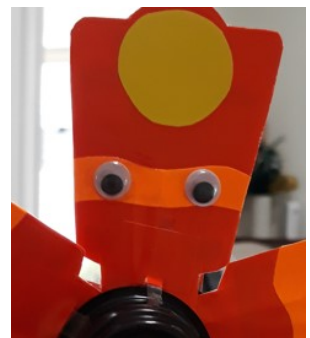
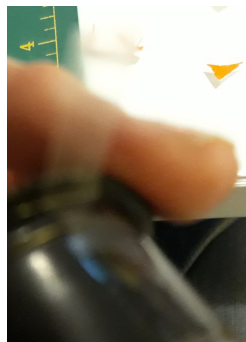
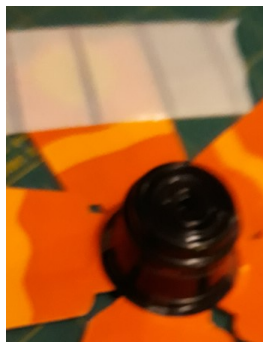
1. Whaea Pam's garden labels reminded me of flower petals. Some of you have five, some have seven. Some have cardboard shapes because I ran out of labels!
2. Find the colour in your pack you have the most of. Cover your labels on both sides. Then press around the edges of the label so you can see where to cut.



3. Lay the pieces out in the shape of a flower so you can work out how to space them. Then cut strips of the same colour and one-by-one, stick them on to make the centre of the flower.
4. Decorate both sides using the other colours (not black; you need that later)



5. Stick the stem on one side.
6. Stick the coffee pods on each side. Cut the clear stickers in strips to do this, then use strips of the flower colour and black strips across the clear strips to hold them firmly down.



7. Stick the awake roly eyes on one side.
8. Draw the asleep eyes on the other
9. Push the stem into a pot and name your pet.

(I used some old wheat bag seeds in my pot so it would not topple and also keep the stem straight. Maybe sand or dirt or rice?)
