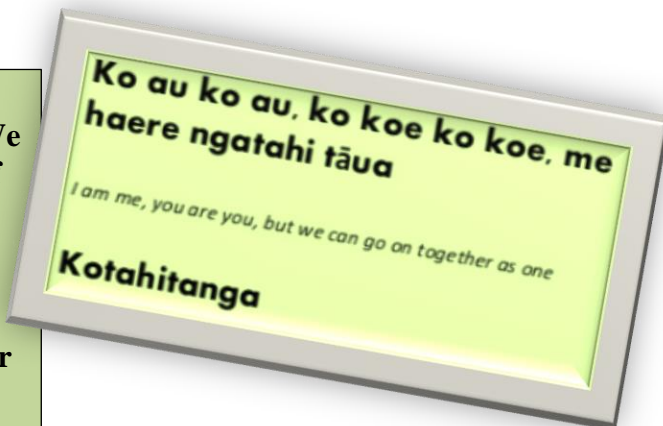

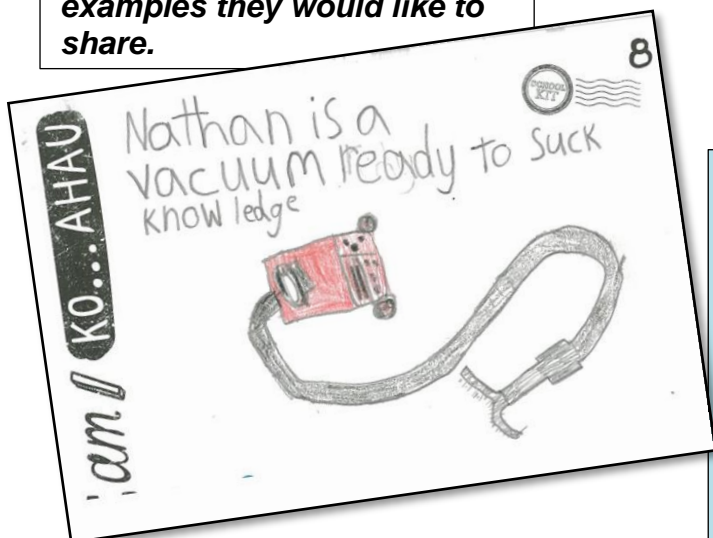
Our Focus: This week we are looking specifically at the **U** in **KORAU** which stands for **Unite**.
