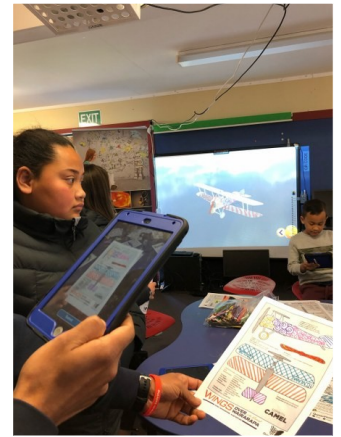
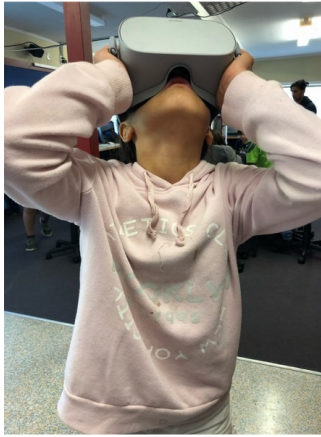
**\$ from Ruud Kleinpaste presentation**

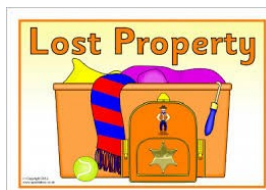
### **YEAR 6 CAMP MEETING**

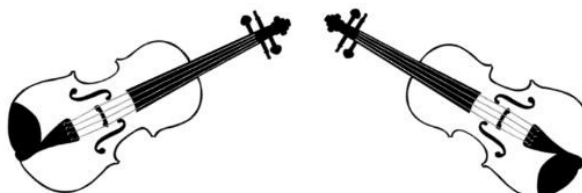
