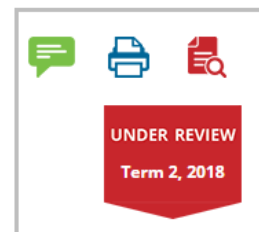

If your child comes home with some new named clothing, this has been provided by the school already.



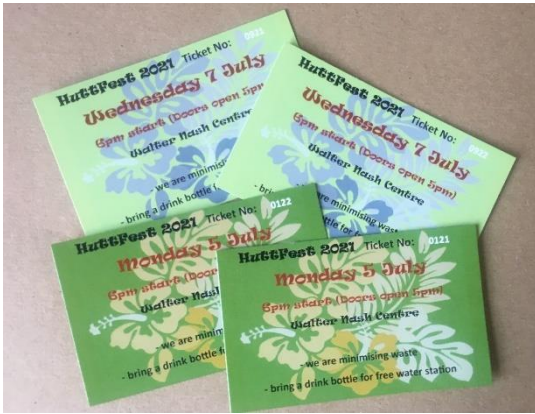
HUTTFEST SUPPORT

STUDENT ABSENCES

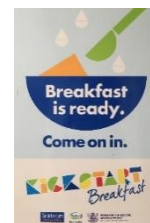
