COVID-19 VACCINATION MANDATE INFORMATION

At 11.59pm on Monday 25 October the COVID-19 Public Health Response Order for Mandatory Vaccinations for Education came into effect.



Everyone who works or volunteers in a school, who **may** have contact with children or students, or may be present at a time when children or students are also present must have had a first dose of the COVID-19 vaccine by 15 November 2021 and be fully vaccinated by 1 January 2022.

The vaccination requirements apply wherever "in person" schooling occurs, such as on the school site, but also at school camps, swimming pools, museums, or where other education outside the classroom (EOTC) programmes take place.

This means that only those who have had their first dose by 15 November 2021 and are fully vaccinated by 1 January 2022 are able to help at school events.

If you wish to be involved as a helper in any events after 15 November 2021, please email through or pop by school with evidence of your vaccination status. When school starts next year, we will need evidence of full vaccination for all school helpers. We will store your information privately in our school database.

The requirements do not apply to people who are just dropping off or picking up children from school.
