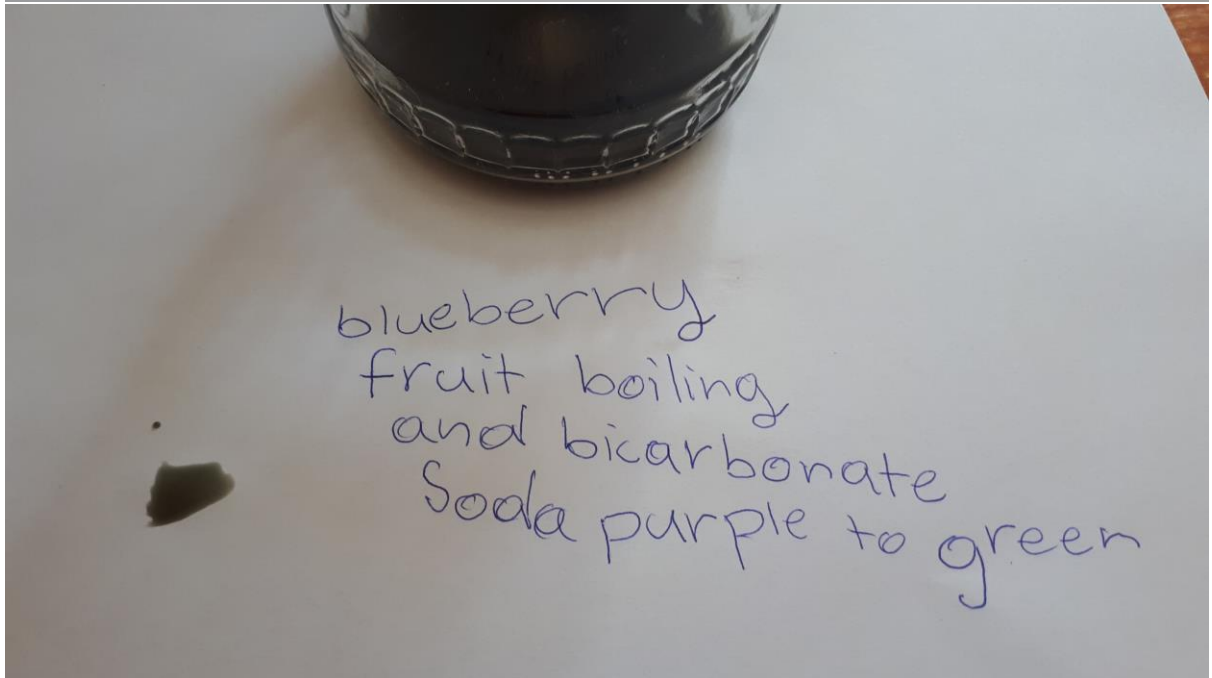
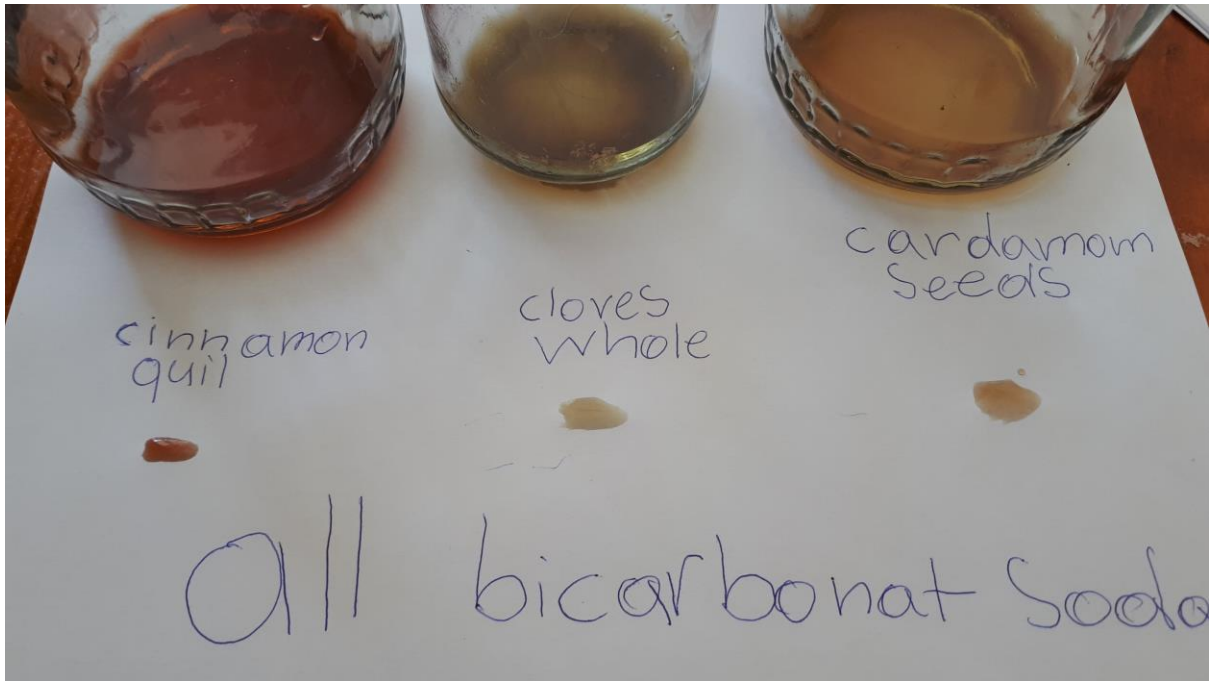
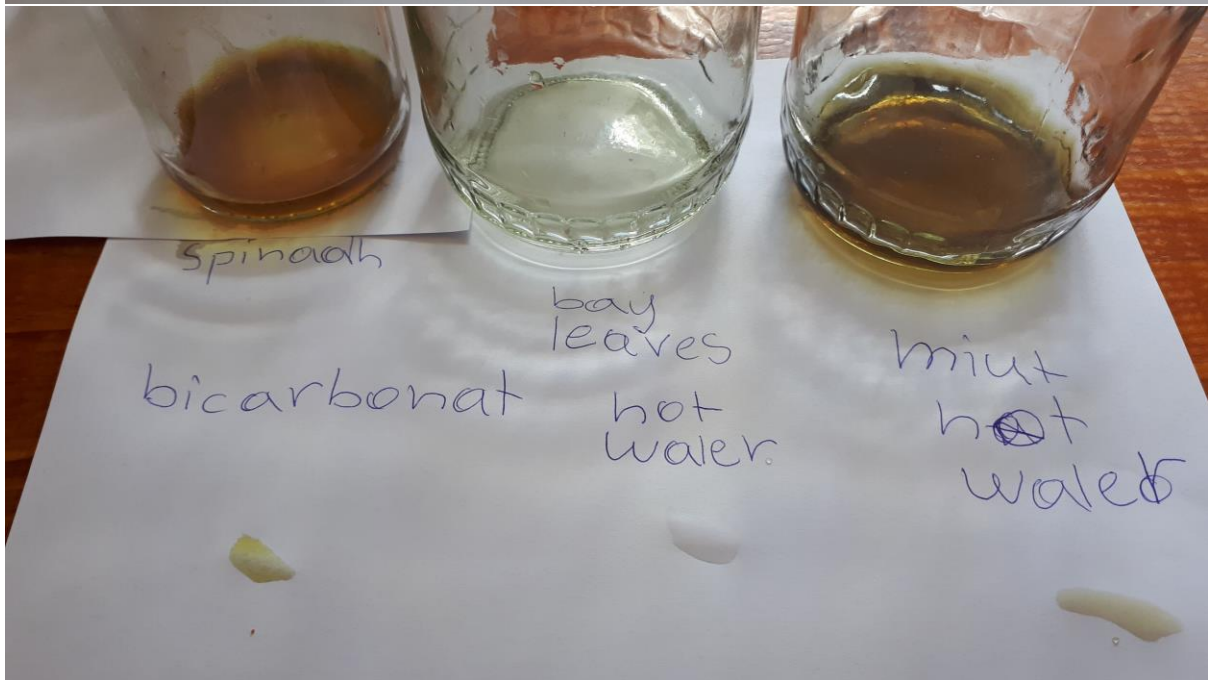
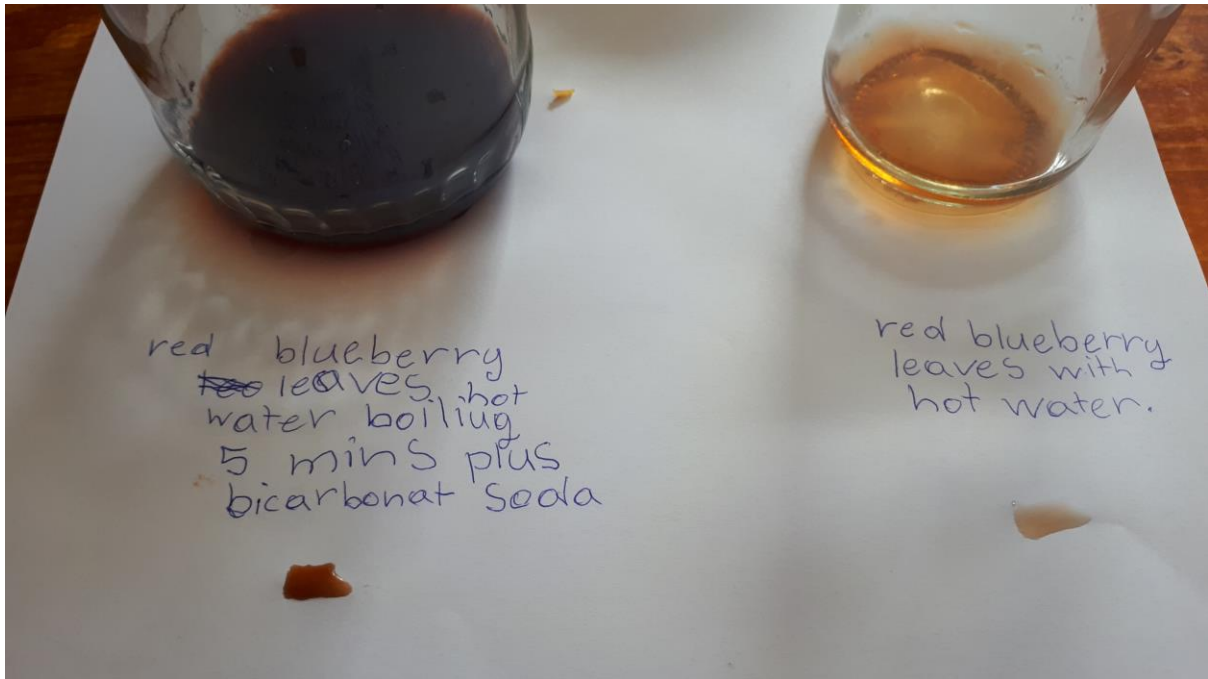
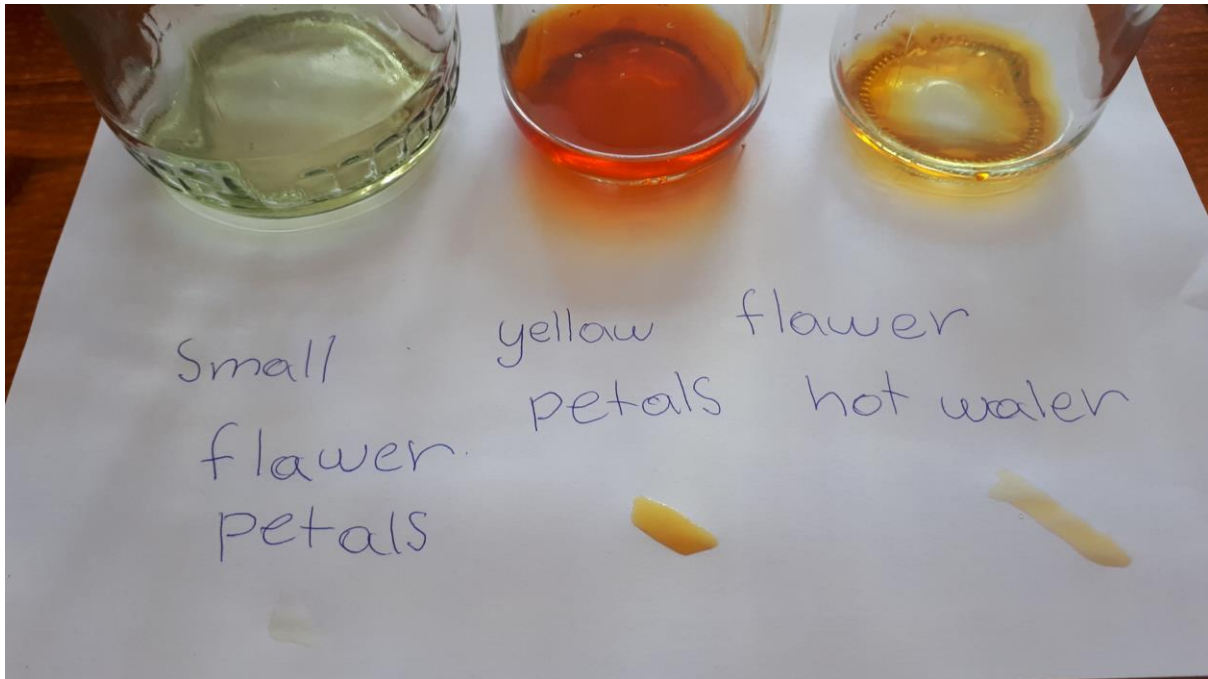


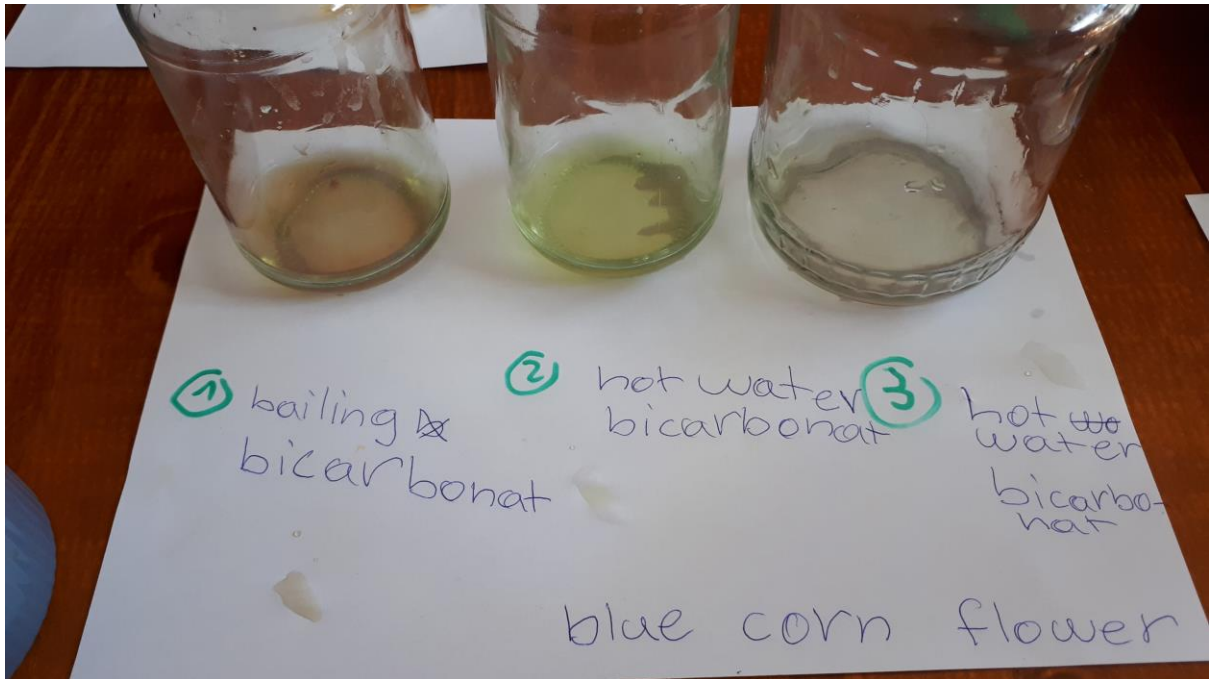


Bicarbonat of soda crystalised when cooled down (used with small yellow petals, boiling for approx. 5 mins).

Water colors
we went outside in our garden and collected flowers and leaves. We wanted to make water colors. we used yellow petal flowers, blue corn flowers, red chiles and peppers, spinach spices and mint. we cut up the flowers and vegetable and poured boiling water over it. we added bicarbonate of soda to get a stronger color. we noticed a few things:

- yellow petals make strong colors.
- Blue petals make a weak color.
- using bicarbonate of soda with petals liquid crystallises when color down.
- using bicarbonate of soda with blueberry turns color from purple to green.
- using bicarbonate of soda with vegetables leaves and spices makes dark colors and liquid does not crystallise when color down.
